COMPETITION LEVELS

Untitled:	Suitable for inexperienced dogs and handlers. Standard Course Time (SCT) is that of AAC Starters level. Dogs should be competing at their normal competition jump height. If you want your dog to jump one jump height lower Select "Special Class".
Number of years at K9Kup	Dog (or junior handler) that has previously been at competitor in K-9 Kup for more than 3 seasons will be assessed a handicap for each run equivalent to the that of an AAC – Starters title (ADC).
AAC Title:	Dog (or junior handler) that holds an AAC – Starters Title (ADC) will be assessed a handicap for each run.
Regular Class:	Dogs compete at normal jump heights as specified by AAC rules.
Special Class:	Dogs competing one or two jump heights lower than their normal height. The spread, broad and double jumps are not included and the A-Frame will be set at 5' only. Standard Course Time "SCT" will be the same as the Regular Class.
Veteran Class:	Dogs 5 years or older competing one or two jump heights lower than their normal height. The spread, broad and double jumps are not included and the A-Frame will be set at 5' only. Standard Course time "SCT" will be greater than the Regular Class.
Junior Handlers	Aged 17 years or younger. A junior handler can run a dog regardless of the dog's level of accomplishment. We handicap the junior handler based on the their level of handling and previous K-9 Kup experience the very same as we do for the dogs. The junior handler is the official competitor, not the dog. Please see rules at www.aac.ca for more on junior handlers. Please note, that we ask that all Junior Handlers under the age of 14 be accompanied by an adult on the day of the event.
Running on Leash	Permitted but with some restrictions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Entirely at the handler's own risk - Their score will be forfeited and not count towards their team standings. - Prior to the K9 Kup a handler should have approached their respective agility club's instructor to ensure that safety concerns for running on leash have been addressed and been taught best practices for doing so. - Judges may call the handler and dog off the field if either the handler or dog is acting in a consistent manner that may cause injury (to either the handler or dog).
Entry Restrictions:	K-9 Kup will be restricted to 14 teams of a maximum of 10 dogs per team. ADSC must receive full payment from all team members before the team will be registered. A notice will be posted on the ADSC website once the maximum number of teams have been reached. Applications received after that time will be returned and the applicant(s) notified.

Note: *Dogs with Advanced (AADC) or Master (MADC) Titles at time of registration are no longer able to compete in the K9 Kup unless run by a junior handler.*

Dogs obtaining any Titles after registration closes or throughout the summer will be assessed the handicaps for the remaining events.
