General Information - Notice to Participants

Each evening trial at All Dogs Sports Club has only one level of competition and therefore move-ups are not available. However, a title gained early at the trial does not preclude the dog from competing in the remaining events for qualifying scores, even if now below the dog's level

Competitors, through the submission of their entry, acknowledge that they know the AAC rules and regulations. **All dogs must have an AAC identification number and enter it on the entry form.** NOTE: AAC regulations require the handler to obtain an ID card directly from the AAC. If you do not have an AAC ID card for your dog, please obtain the AAC Registration Form from the AAC website (http://www.aac.ca/en/forms/pdf/AAC_DogIDCardEN.pdf) and submit it directly to the AAC. A valid AAC card must be presented at the trial check-in for all dogs in any starters class events, and for all dogs running for the first time at ADSC trials. You may also be requested to show your AAC Dog ID card at any time by the judge or the Clubs, so please be sure to have it with you.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather. Refunds will be issued for dogs that come into heat or are injured, providing the Trial Secretary receives a veterinarian's certificate within 48 hours of the start of the trial.

Come for all weather conditions and bring chairs. As there are no provisions for sun or rain, bring shade/rain gear and sun block. Water for the dogs will be available around the show area.

Obstacles may include: A-frame, Dog Walk, Teeter, Weave Poles, Table, Flexible Tunnels, Collapsible Tunnel, Tire Jump, Spread Jump, Double Bar Jumps, Single Bar Jumps, Broad Jump.

Volunteering for Priority Entry

Volunteering at an ADSC trial will give you priority entry into this trial. Priority entry only applies to ADSC evening Masters and Steeplechase trials. (Note that ADSC members have agreed to a club volunteer commitment and therefore receive priority entry automatically, with no additional volunteer commitment required to obtain priority entrance).

Our volunteer situation has changed from previous years which has resulted in changes to our priority entrance policy.

- 1) **It is the total number of runs you are doing, with all dogs combined, that determines the amount of volunteering you must do.**

It does not have to be you who personally does the volunteering. i.e. you can recruit someone to do it for you

- 2) **The following count as priority for 4 evening trial runs (a full evening trial):**

a) Volunteer for a full evening trial, all 4 events not running a dog.

b) Full event position for 2 runs at an ADSC/OVBCC weekend trial at any level (Masters, Advanced, Starters).

- 3) **The following count as priority for 2 evening trial runs:**

a) Full event position for one run at an ADSC/OVBCC weekend trial at any level (Masters, Advanced, Starters).

b) 3:30 pre-trial set-up of an evening trial

- 4) **You must volunteer on our web site and specify it on the entry form before priority will be given.**

Priority entry for evening trials runs can be across trials. For example, earning 4 runs could be used as priority entry for 2 runs in each evening masters trial.

Check the volunteer box and indicate what you have volunteered for on the entry form to gain priority entry.

Entrance Priority

This is a limited entry trial, entrance is on a first come/first in basis. ADSC members have priority entrance.

Awards

- Placement ribbons for 1st through 4th place for each division
- Qualifying rosettes for all AAC agility qualifiers
- Titling rosettes acknowledging dogs who achieve an AAC agility title
- Prizes for the best run in a competitive grouping, typically Regular and Specials/Veterans. More prize categories are added when numbers warrant it.
